This unique course will provide students with the opportunity to learn as an international learning community, access international expertise in implementation, and network with implementation research leaders across the globe.

The course aims to increase participant's personal and scientific facilitation capabilities regarding implementation research. The course content includes the following topics: introduction to implementation science, stakeholder involvement in the process of facilitation, macro, meso and micro context prerequisites, and evaluation of implementation work. Successful completion of the course earns **7.5 ECTS**.

The course will start January 18th, 2021 and end April 9th, 2021. There will be three modules each two days, 18th and 19th of January, 8th and 9th of February, and 8th and 9th of March, examination date will be 9th of April.

The course is free of charge.
